Bird houses? The Wildlife Management Plan (WMP) that we've filed with the county and state require each property owner to fulfill three of seven "management practices" to sustain one of the wildlife species our plan dictates we support. One of the species our plan supports is songbirds and one of the management practices is shelter (or houses); thus bird houses.

The HCRHA will pay for the supplies to build these simple bird houses and we have the able assistance of property owners Dick Van Dyke and Doug Musel to show us how to do it. All you need to do is show up and be willing to work on bird houses that will be used on your HCR property.
